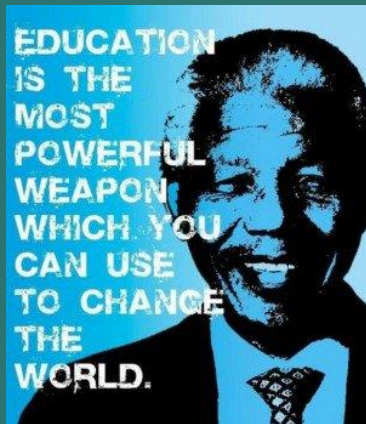

Grants For Clergy Continuing Education

Grant Guidelines:

We are pleased to provide some funding for ongoing learning opportunities for our clergy. Here are some guidelines:

- In Good Standing
- Commissioned or Ordained
- Paid Minister's Association Dues previous 12 months.
- Only 1 request per two years
- First come first serve
- 30 day notice before the event.

Grant Process:

- Please fill out a "Request For Clergy Continuing Education Grant" form *well in advance of your event!* Forms are available from the Regional Office.
- It is expected that the clergyperson will secure funds from other sources, including their own resources and those of their local congregation, in addition to the CCCA Minister's Association.
- Submit the form to the Regional Minister. It is helpful to attach brochures, flyers, or web links to the event.
- You will be asked to share with the Minister's Association about your Continuing Education experience.
