### **The John Dale Showell Family Chapel**

The chapel and meditation area is a space within the hospital important for well-being and healing of the whole person. The chapel is an environment of comfort when patients and family members are grappling with issues that directly affect their health and well-being. In the process of coping with crises, guilt, loneliness, pain, anxiety, fear of death or fear of some other loss, the chapel and meditation area serves as a place to focus on spiritual strength and encouragement.

The Chapel is available at all times. It is located on the second floor on the East wing of 2 North.

**Directions from the main entrance:**

1. Use the elevator in the main entrance to go up to the second floor
2. Take an immediate right upon exiting the elevator
3. Follow the hallway past both nurse stations
4. Take a right at the blue sign
5. Follow the hallway all the way to the end until you arrive at The Chapel
